

## **COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS 2021**

Upon arrival at location all coaches, volunteers, and players are required to check in with the Board Member on Duty for an entry screening.

- If any of the above have symptoms or have been exposed to a person who has COVID, they should not attend any AVGSA events.
- Any player or coach experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, or living with someone experiencing symptoms, must stay home.
- Players or coaches who become symptomatic must report to the AVGSA Board and consult their physician for testing.
- Youths recovering from COVID-19 will require physician clearance before returning to play after a positive test. Coaches and volunteers will need to be symptom free for 10 days and/or present a negative COVID-19 test to the Board
- If a coach, volunteer, or player has a confirmed case of COVID, the County of Los Angeles DPH will be notified.

Spectators will be limited to household members only and will be required to remain six feet apart from other households.

Masks will be required at all times by parents, coaches, and players.

- AVGSA will provide signage requiring mask usage at all times
- Disposable masks will be provided for players and coaches as needed

Players in dugouts will be six feet apart.

- Any backpacks/bags/personal items will also be required to be six feet apart
- AVGSA will provide cones to define spacing

Hand sanitizing stations will be present in each dugout.

 Each player and coach will be required to sanitize hands entering and leaving dugout

Sanitizing wipes will be required for cleaning of shared equipment, including softballs.

- All balls will be sanitized when clinic groups/coaches change
- · Each dugout will be sanitized when groups change



There will be no sharing of drink bottles or other personal items.

Coaches and players will remain six feet apart.

 If players are lined up for drill, cones will be used to define 6 ft distance separation

AVGSA COVID waiver must be completed an on file for all participants.

If a coach, volunteer, player, or spectator is unwilling to follow any of the above listed protocols, they will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
